Schurppfe, County Judge of Kendall County, Texas, warden of "Crows Creek Cemetery", in Precinct No. three in the County and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, sell and convey unto the said F. W. Schurppfe, as warden of said cemetery and his successors, all that certain tract or parcel of land, described as follows, to-wit:

Situated in Kendall County, Texas, on the waters of Crows Creek, a

tributary of the Guadalupe River,
about 16, miles N. 52 E. of Brown.

Said cemetery is situated on the
Alfred Welso Sur. N. 52, and S 8 1/2 W.
550. distant from E. cor. of said survey
for E. corner of said cemetery whence
double q' L. O. N. 16. W. 11 3/5. ss - to a q' L. O. S.
54 1/2 W. 11 3/5. ss. Thence N. 26. W. 167 ss. to
corner whence 10' P. O. S. 37 1/2 W. q' ss. q'
P. O. S. 3 E. 10 3/5. ss. Thence S. 64 W. 167 ss.

the said premises, unto said F. W.
Schurppe, cemetery warden and his suc-
cessors, against every person whosoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof.
