Memorial Services for Mr. Lee James Harwell, age 64, of Cameron, were held at 6:00 p.m. Saturday at the C. H. Yoe Performing Arts Center with Angelo Reyes and Dale Owens as speakers. There were 642 in attendance. Mr. Harwell died Saturday, July 14th at his residence. Mr. Harwell was born January 1, 1948, in Blanco, Texas, to Harold and Theodosia Maxfield Harwell, and was retired from his first career as A T & T International Service Manager for the Caribbean, and his second career as an interpreter, translator and mediator.
